Highway Department – Cody Green

- Detour Agreement with AGE Corporation – Superintendent Green has been approached by AGE Corporation to create a detour of 7 miles through Perkins County’s Horse Creek Township due to a temporary close of Highway 79. Various people were present to request that the Commissioners deny the detour. Foster moved, Schweitzer seconded to deny AGE Corporation access to Horse Creek Township as a detour, motion carried.
- Milling County Roads – Harding County Highway Superintendent Jeremy Humbracht was present to give feedback on milling county roads within Harding County. Humbracht stated they have done 150 miles already and are happy with the little amount of maintenance needed during the 1<sup>st</sup> 10 years. Humbracht said it costs around \$1.28/square yard, which equates to around \$33,000 per mile. Commissioners will consider it as an option in the future.
