

Perkins County comprehensive Plan Committee Meeting, April 22, 2014

The Perkins County Comprehensive Plan Committee met at the Bentley Building in Bison SD on Tuesday, April 22, 2014 at 7:00 PM. The meeting was open to the public for comments and discussion on the proposed plan.

President, Todd Fink called the meeting to order with the following committee members present: Chuck Anderson, Todd Fink, Rownea Gerbracht, Dave Johnson, Dan Kvale, Geraldine Peck and Vaughn Meyer. Ali DeMersseman, Community Development Planner, for the Black Hills Council of Local Governments reviewed the steps leading up to the present public forum. Ali next covered the high points of the plan including purpose, goals and solutions.

President Fink then called for questions and comments from the public attendees. Ali DeMersseman assisted by Blaise Emerson, Executive Director of the Black Hills Council of Local Governments, helped board members answer questions from the audience.
